150 detainees freed from camps

COLOMBO - More than 150 political detainees walked free from military camps today, hours after Sri Lankan President Ranasinghe Premadasa ended a state of emergency in force for over five and a half years. Premadasa, who promised to restore peace in the Indian Ocean island shattered by Tamil and Sinhalese guerrilla violence, signed a proclamation ending the emergency from midnight Wednesday. But the violence continued as three soldiers were killed and three were wounded in an ambush by suspected Marxist rebels at Hungama in the south Wednesday.
