Opposition leader unhurt in attack

COLOMBO — Opposition leader Sirimavo Bandaranaike escaped a bomb attack while campaigning Sunday for the Feb. 15 general elections. She was thrown a few metres when members of a gang lobbed grenades and gasoline bombs at a rally of some 5,000 people at Higūrakgoda in north central Sri Lanka. Police said 33 persons were injured, 10 critically.
