

ICRC and Ven. Walpola Rahula

There was a news item in one of Thailand's English newspapers (The Nation) on the 19th of July on the above subject. It stated that Venerable Walpola Rahula has requested the government of Sri Lanka to expel ICRC from Sri Lanka, as they are supporting the LTTE. I think he is wrong to attack the ICRC at this moment, when they are

fighting really hard for their own survival. Groups like ICRC and other "Peace groups" thrive on war situations and disturbances of peace. They share the loot with arms dealers, drug traffickers, passport racketeers and similar groups.
