INDIA PREPARES TO REAP HER HARVEST

The front page of the Island of Saturday the 19th May 2007 gives us the news that India while outwardly playing down what the LTTE could do with light aircraft has suddenly got into a panic and is now all set to acquire radar equipment from Israel. India is also supposed to follow up the initial installations with very advanced surveillance radars mounted on tethered aerostat blimps even though they are sitting ducks in the air for the LTTE.

The media said that India has reasons to fear because the LTTE murdered Rajiv Gandhi but that is only a superficially visible reason. The real reason why India should fear the LTTE is how India took Prabhakaran for a ride by making him understand that she would carve out a portion of Sri Lanka for the Tamils if he would destabilize Sri Lanka enabling Indian troops to land, carve out Eelam and then return to India. Prabhakaran swallowed it hook, line and sinker.

When the GOSL was about to liquidate the fledgling LTTE, India threatened JR Jayawardene with invasion because the LTTE was not strong enough to carry out the Indian plans but as soon as India brought the strength of the LTTE to a level sufficient to destabilize our country India invaded us to annex our motherland as was originally planned.

Having made use of Prabhakaran and after consolidating the occupation Rajiv Gandhi tried to play the role of international peacekeeper and demanded the LTTE to surrender her arms. The whole of Sri Lanka was made to understand that the Indian troops came here to disarm the LTTE and the Indian Viceroy Dixit ensured that. If at that time we had access to international television the Viceroy would have cut those links. Those of us who were abroad at that time knew what exactly was happening because the television kept us fully informed. The Indian nationals living abroad started treating Sri Lankans as if they were colonial subjects.

When Rajiv Gandhi was asked what he would do if the LTTE did not surrender arms he said in that event they will have to face the Indian army. He paused for a moment and in measured tones like Akashi said that he therefore hopes wisdom will prevail. Those words and the way they were said were far too much for Prabhakaran the man whom India created. The rest is history still unknown to many Sri Lankans who still keep blaming Premadasa for supplying arms to the LTTE to drive the Indians out. These simple minds do not understand that if India was permitted to wipe out the LTTE the next step would have been annexation because we were completely helpless.

Our stupid politicians never wanted to have armed forces capable of defending our sovereignty because they believed that we could never defend ourselves against India. We, not the donkey politicians in the previous regimes, should be grateful to Prabhakaran for giving us the confidence to protect our sovereignty against Indian plans. Today India will dare not attempt to invade.

The LTTE will never forgive India for making use of her to achieve a different aim. The LTTE now has an assortment of masters for whom the availability of large numbers of Indian scientists of international repute and the resources of India as a whole that are sufficient for the development component of Research and Development has been a headache for quite some time. If India is permitted to proceed she will be so very competitive in all fields including those in the high-tech that the living standards of the West would start dropping dramatically. All it needs to achieve that would be to get the LTTE to lever Tamil Nadu out of the federation and the rest will fall like the dominos. That will be the only way India can avoid reaping the harvest she has sown on us.
