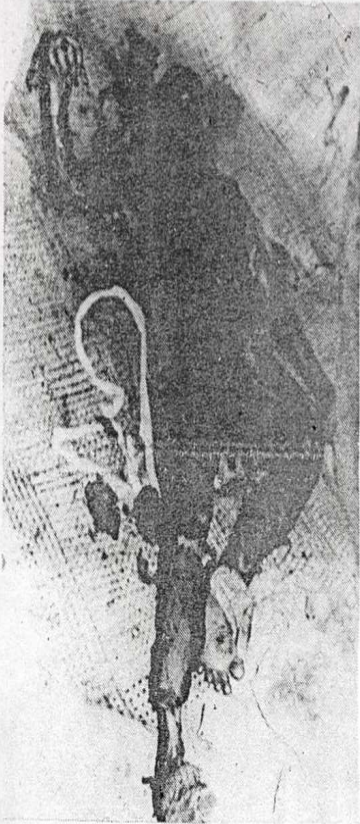

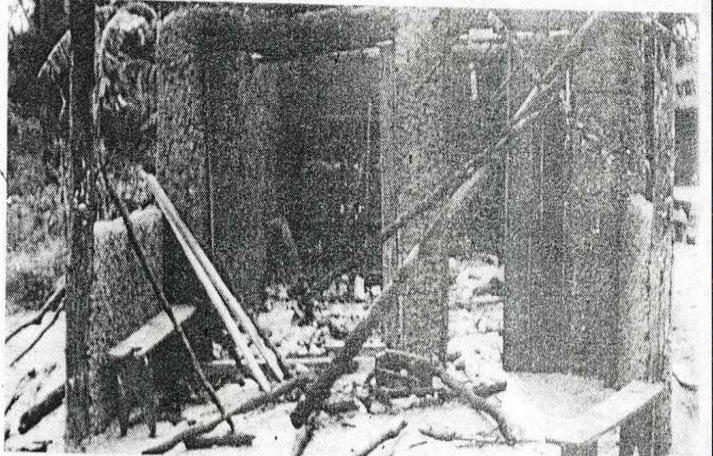
The remains of a seventeen-year-old-girl, P. M. Chamila who was brutally gunned down and burnt by the Tigers during the raid on the village.
